Sex & Gender

- Sex: assigned male and female based on physical characteristics
- Gender: The internal sense that people have of who they are that come from the interaction of biological traits, developmental influences, and environmental conditions
 - What makes a boy a boy? What makes a girl a girl?
 - most children can easily label themselves either as a boy or a girl by age 3
 - they will continue to explore their gender identity through middle & late childhood, which will inform their sexual identity development in the teenage years.

Societal Understanding of Gender Identity is Changing

- Gender is a social contract it defines how each gender should dress, what each gender should do, and how each gender ought to behave.
- The damaging effect:
 - limits how each gender can express themselves
 - · limits professional aspiration & contribution to the world
 - · limits behavior
- Modern-Day Gender Identity is <u>fluid</u>
 - · More than 2 ways of identifying gender
 - changing of gender identity
 - · people use different pronouns

How should we parent?

- Root yourself in the truth
 - What does the Bible say about sex & gender?
 - What are the areas that Bible kept silent?
- Be curious and have open conversations
 - · reflective listening & ask questions
- Challenge societal Gender Norms
 - provide opportunities for exploration and conversations
 - jump in with biblical teachings
- teach your child how to respond to different beliefs
 - · focus on what our family believes
